METHODOLOGY

QUANTITATIVE RESEARCH INSTRUMENT

A survey of 1633 Canadians was completed online between October 9-12, 2017 using Leger's online panel, *LegerWeb*.

A probability sample of the same size would yield a margin of error of +/-2.5%, 19 times out of 20.

ABOUT LEGER'S ONLINE PANEL

Leger's online panel has approximately 475,000 members nationally – with between 10,000 and 20,000 new members added each month, and has a retention rate of 90%.

QUALITY CONTROL

OWNING WINTER TIRES

Two-Thirds (66%) of Canadians who drive and/or own a car, own winter tires, while one-third (33%) do not. Atlantic Canadians and Quebecers are significantly more likely than all other provinces to own winter tires (85% vs 58%). Among those who do not own winter tires, nearly three-quarters (72%) believe they are not needed with half (51%) saying all-season tires are good enough. Those in the rest of Canada (vs Quebecers) who drive and/or own a car, are significantly more likely to believe that winter tires are not needed (75% vs 46%) and more specifically those in the rest of Canada are more likely to believe that all-season tires are good enough (55% vs 11%). 

OWNING WINTER TIRES



One-fifth (22%) of Canadians who drive and/or own a car are considering the purchase of winter tires for this upcoming winter season.

Younger Canadians, Canadians who do not currently own winter tires, Canadians with children <18 in their household, as well as Canadians living in the Prairie Provinces or Ontario are significantly more likely to say they are considering the purchase of winter tires this season.
