Description:

The incumbent will also provide, on occasion, strategic advice and leadership on complex corporate and governmental issues and projects and will work alongside TRAC staff and industry colleagues to assist in the development of effective strategies.

- Lead and direct discussions at meetings with members to create industry forecasts and related intelligence gathering

- Develop and maintain positive relations with member companies, industry organizations, government partners, media, and other stakeholder groups
- Work in collaboration with Association staff to develop communications plans to leverage strategic industry and government partnerships
